ABSTRACT

Introduction

Regardless as to what people may say about this writer, I could not make this stuff up if I tried.

The results will invariably be worse than 1929 because of the global nature of the ensuing conflicts, and the sad fact that even moderate economic stresses, can cause hungry people to turn on each other, just like rats (see section 2.1).

At one point, Klarenberg’s interrogators demanded to know whether The Grayzone had a special arrangement with Russia’s Federal Security Bureau (FSB) to publish hacked material.

During Klarenberg’s detention, police seized the journalist’s electronic devices and SD cards, fingerprinted him, took DNA swabs, and photographed him intensively. They threatened to arrest him if he did not comply.

Klarenberg’s interrogation appears to be London’s way of retaliating for the journalist’s blockbuster reports exposing major British and US intelligence intrigues. In the past year alone, Klarenberg [revealed](#) how a cabal of Tory national security hardliners violated the Official Secrets Act to exploit Brexit and install Boris Johnson as prime minister. In October 2022, he earned [international headlines](#) with his exposé of [British plans to bomb the Kerch Bridge](#) connecting Crimea to the Russian Federation. Then

came his [report](#) on the CIA's recruitment of two 9/11 hijackers this April, a viral sensation that generated massive social media attention.

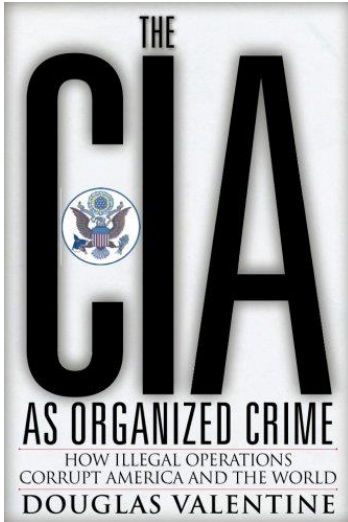

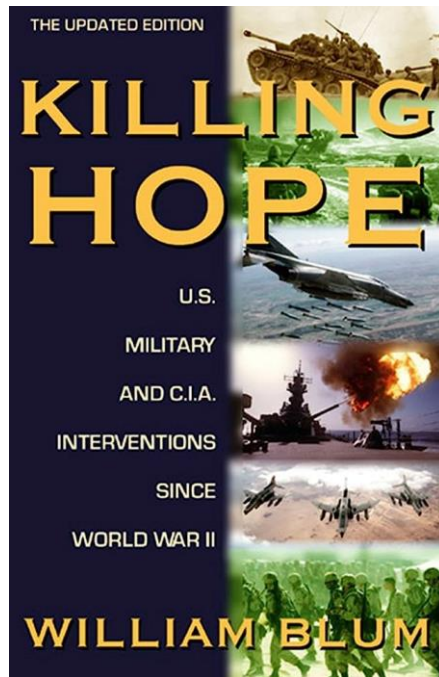

The bank said that history implies that S&P 500 multiple is about 2.5x overvalued amid a vulnerability in corporate profits.

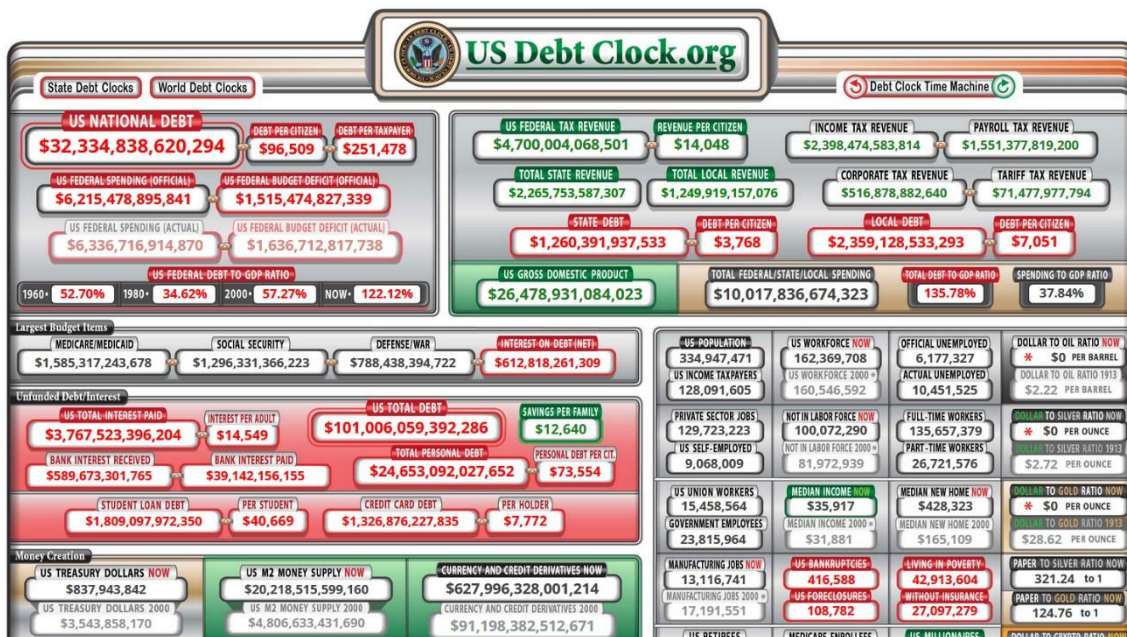
"Risk-reward for equities remains poor in our view, reinforcing our underweight equity stance," JPMorgan's Marko Kolanovic said.

In the United States, [suicides](#) outnumber [homicides](#) almost two to one. Perhaps the real tragedy behind suicide deaths—about 30,000 a year, one for every 45 attempts—is that so many could be prevented. Research shows that whether attempters live or die depends in large part on the ready availability of highly lethal means, especially firearms.

A study by the Harvard School of Public Health of all 50 U.S. states reveals a powerful link between rates of firearm ownership and suicides. Based on a survey of American households conducted in 2002, HSPH Assistant Professor of [Health Policy and Management](#) [Matthew Miller](#), Research Associate Deborah Azrael, and colleagues at the [School's Injury Control Research Center](#) (ICRC), found that in states where guns were prevalent—as in Wyoming, where 63 percent of households reported owning

guns—rates of suicide were higher. The inverse was also true: where gun ownership was less common, suicide rates were also lower.

“President James Knox Polk is often lauded for his achievements as president, including the territorial acquisition of the western portion of the nation. Critical attention to this legacy mostly focuses on his rhetorical strategy for putting the nation into war with Mexico.

“To date, no studies focus on Polk’s rhetorical strategy for ending the war. In this article, I examine Polk’s end-of war rhetoric, attending to his rationalizations for exiting the war, his justification for resuming diplomatic relations with Mexico, and his identification of a new enemy requiring presidential and national attention.

“I argue that Polk’s pivot from Mexicans to Indians rhetorically transferred tropes of savagery to Indians, reenergized violence against Indians, and facilitated the institutionalization of management of Indian affairs via the creation of the Department of the Interior.

“I conclude that rhetorical critics should closely attend to the way end-of-war rhetoric enables presidents to transition from one enemy to another while reaping institutional benefits.”
